Characteristics

Genus & Species: Protection Status:	<i>Dianthus hybrida</i> PP20,628; COPF Open.		
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).		
Bloom:	Gorgeous fragrant large double blooms, crisp white in color with a bright burgundy eye, carried on sturdy stems. Repeat blooming.		
Bloom Period:	Early season – Fall.		
Foliage:	Glaucous, blue green foliage.		
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 14-18" x 10-14".		
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. License required for propagation.		
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.		
Additional Comments:	No vernalization required for blooming. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.		
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting, Cut Flower.

6" - Gallons:	10-16 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
