Characteristics

Genus & Species:	Dianthus hybrida
Protection Status:	PP18,828; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Masses of fragrant, double, white blooms with burgundy red centers carried on short stems.
Bloom Period:	Spring – fall.
Foliage:	Glaucous, blue green foliage.
Habit:	Compact clump forming habit 10" x 10". (Pot Selections: 8-10")
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. License required for propagation.
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Flower stems are short and sturdy and do not flop. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting, Cut Flower.

4.5"- Quarts:	8-10 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	10-16 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
