Key Features

✓ Red single blooms. Repeat blooming.

✓ Glaucous foliage with unique dense mounding habit.

✓ No vernalization required for blooming.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Dianthus hybrida

Protection Status: PP 14,437; COPF Open.

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Red single blooms, with a maroon eye and a shower of white stamens, carried on sturdy

stems. Repeat blooming.

Bloom Period: Spring – fall.

Glaucous, blue green foliage. Foliage: Habit: Compact mounding habit 6" x 6".

Propagation: Tip Cuttings. License required for propagation.

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: No vernalization required for blooming. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead

headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.
