blooming.

Bloom Period: Early season - Fall.

Habit: Compact mounding habit 14-18" x 10-14". **Propagation:** Tip Cuttings. License required for propagation.

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: No vernalization required for blooming. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead

headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.

4.5"- Quarts: 8-10 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting). 6" - Gallons: 10-16 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
